The setup also featured enthusiastic little vendors selling toys and gifts, and even a charming mini Starbucks shop, all adding to the real-life airport ambiance.



A full-scale airplane model was created where students played the roles of passengers, complete with a luggage area, baggage scanners, and a waiting lounge. Each stage of the airport process was thoughtfully simulated – luggage scanning, passport and boarding pass checks, waiting at the terminal, and finally, boarding the aircraft.



Inside the aircraft, the air hostesses greeted passengers with a warm Namaste, checked boarding passes, and served snacks and drinks as the pilots "flew" the plane from the cockpit.
